

WP 3 - EVALUATION

Cancer Control Joint Action



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What about? (Short description)

- WP3 provides a systematic approach for the internal evaluation of the Joint Action
 - (a) a process evaluation (formative evaluation) - in terms of compliance to the rules and implementation of the JA,
 - (b) an output evaluation - in terms of compliance to the content and achievement of the objectives of the JA; and
 - (c) an outcome evaluation (summative evaluation) - concerning the usefulness of the outcomes, recommendations and sustainability beyond the JA
- Methodology - the evaluation combines different types of data and methods (quantitative and qualitative). Reporting - through Joint Action meetings and through two interim and one final evaluation reports.

How we stand? (Current status)

- Participation in all CANCON meetings (up to now)
- Monthly workgroup meetings
- Evaluation of the Stakeholder Forum (Brussels, June 2014) – online survey - 10 questions
- Elaboration of the Evaluation Strategy (ready to be disseminated)
- Start the elaboration of the evaluation questionnaires (first draft due in january 2015)
- Start create the assessment process and guidelines for the Expert Reference Groups

Collaboration with other WPs

- All the evaluation indicators are defined in close collaboration with the WPs
- Defining an Expert Reference Group – each WP to be represented (contact person, data collection, help on critical assessment of relevant deliverables)
- Organizing Focus groups for discussing and appraising the impact and sustainability of the Joint Action during conferences and for the preparation of the final evaluation report (participants will be identified later by the Joint Action Management Office in collaboration with relevant WPs and partners on the basis of the stakeholder analysis and required scientific expertise)
