

Sustainability and access: mutually exclusively or mutually supportive?

A health system and a European perspective

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NCCPs in the EU Member States 2011-2016

Analysis of the situation in two cross-sectional surveys

In 24 countries indicators are/will be used in the process of evaluation of their NCCPs:

AT, BE, CY, CZ, DK, EE, FI, FR, HU, IS, IE, IT, LV, LT, LU, ME, PL, PT, SI, ES, SE, TR, EN, WA.

In only 2 countries indicators will not be used for evaluation: MT and RO.

In 16 countries indicators are defined in the NCCP/Cancer document/s:

AT, CY, CZ, DK, EE, HU, IS, LV, LT, LU, SI, ES, SE, TR, EN, WA.

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1. **Nine countries reported positive results in terms of decreased cancer incidence, stage-shifting, mortality or survival: BE, CZ, FR, IE, PT, SI, TR, EN, WA.**
2. **Sixteen countries did not report any results:**
AT, DK, EE, FI, DE, IS, IT, LV, LT, LU, MT, ME, NO, RO, ES, SE.
1. **25 countries responded to the question regarding the methods of evaluation they use.**
 - I. 11 countries reported that they use all three methods of evaluation (by structure, by process or/and by outcome): BE, CY, DK, DE, IT, LT, LU, ES, SE, TR, WA.
 - II. 9 countries use only one method, mostly evaluation by outcome; 5 countries use two methods.
 - III. In 21 countries the evaluation is done by outcome, while evaluation by process is used in 17 countries Finally, 14 countries evaluate by structure.

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+++ Quality aspects of cancer care and on rehabilitation, while still only few NCCPs elaborate clearly the issues related to survivorship.

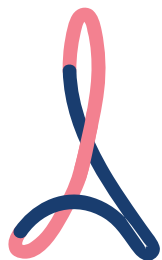
--- Financing, cancer resources (human resources, infrastructure, health technology, cancer specific expenditure) and access to innovative cancer treatments.

o In almost all countries there is a national or regional authority/body dedicated to the coordination of actions related to the NCCPs in order to

- 1. Ensure the proper implementation**
- 2. Regular communication to the public regarding the implementation/evaluation of the cancer document/s was established.**
