Members and Mandate of the Expert Group on Cancer Control

This Commission Expert Group consists essentially of **organisations** (in the broad sense) and **Member States.**

Mission:

Assist the Commission in the preparation of legislation or in policy definition and facilitate an exchange of views and coordination



1st Meeting 23-24 September, Milan

- 1. **implementation report** presented by the Commission
- 2. state-of play on the **CANCON Joint Action** and progress towards a **European Cancer Information System**
- 3. International Agency for Research on Cancer presented the methodology of the 4th edition of the **European Code Against Cancer**



Results of the 2nd meeting 3-4 March (Luxemburg)

- Reflection on prevention activities in the field of cancer, notably the dissemination of the European Code against Cancer.
- 2. Planned actions in the field of cancer, namely
 - the follow-up on the informal Council discussions on palliative care
 - the proposal for future action on rare cancers.
- 3. Discussed the key points on the Roadmap for the Expert Group.
