•(integrated cancer control; community-level cancer care; survivorship and rehabilitation; screening)

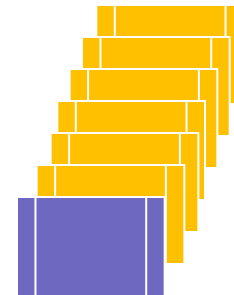
# KEY DELIVERABLES
