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WP Objective

To improve community cancer care of populations through early cancer detection, more coherent continued cancer care and cancer survivor support

WP SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- To provide patient pathways for cancer patients in primary/community care
- To develop intersectoral approaches for comprehensive cancer patient care
- To increase cancer awareness in younger populations at risk in order to improve early diagnosis and early onset of treatment

KEY DELIVERABLES

- Chapter defining the role and the functions of Primary and Community Cancer Care
- Digital Communication Platform for cancer prevention
