#### **Expert Group on Cancer Control: so far**

Meetings: 4 (+ 1 oncoming) meetings

#### Members:

- 45 from EU MS (including alternates)
- 3 from EEA Countries (Norway, Iceland)
- 3 from Candidate countries (Turkey, Serbia)
- 27 from NGOs, academia, scientific association and representatives of producers, international bodies
- Observers: 5
