CanCon and OECD

Criteria for Comprehensive Cancer Networks (1)

- CCN should be centred on a Comprehensive Cancer Centre which would itself qualify to be a CCC
- CCN should as a whole fulfill all the requirements of a CCC
- The corporate leadership of the CCN should be fully responsible for care, research and education in the network according to the OECD quality standards



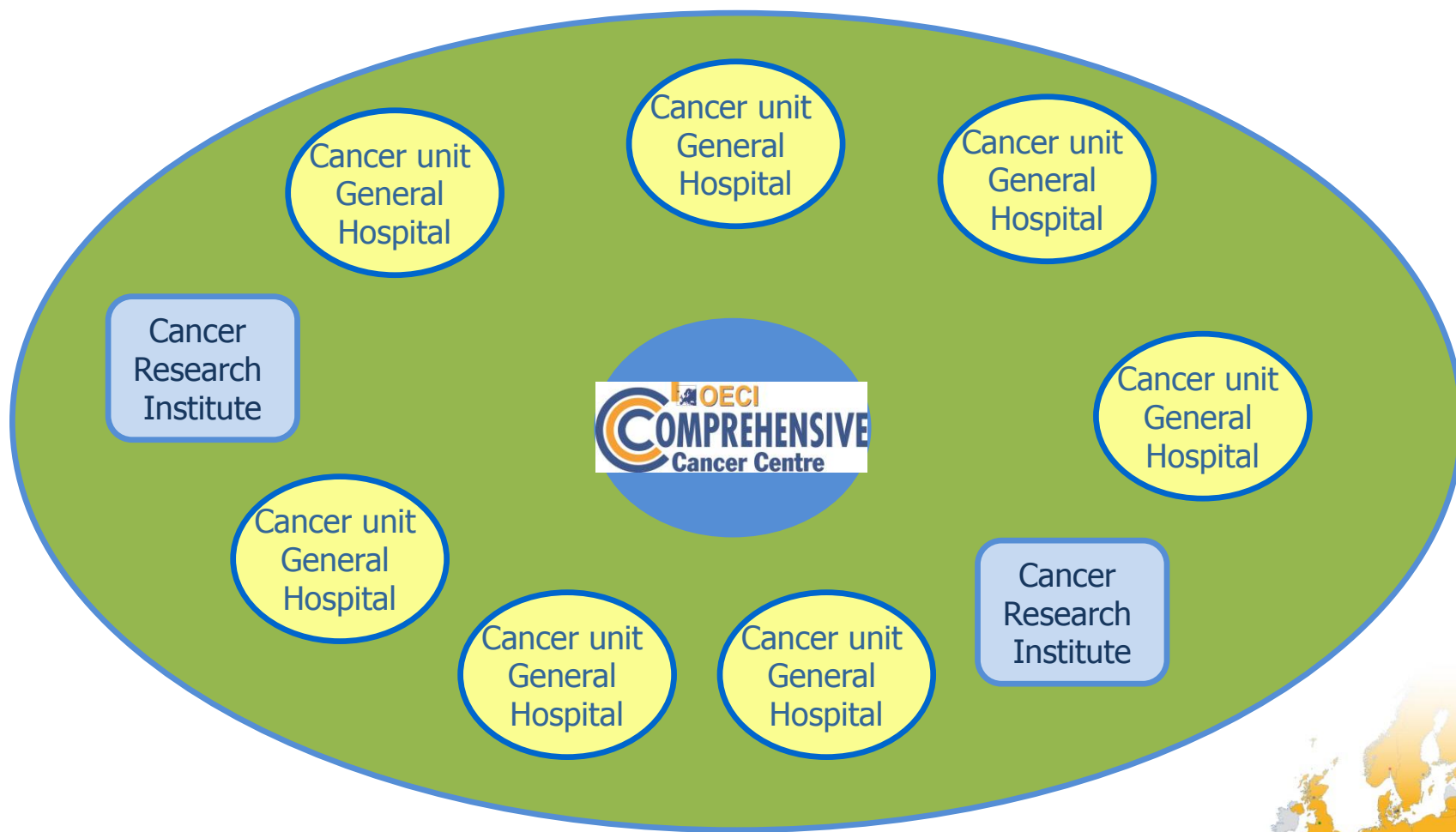
CanCon and OECD

Criteria for Comprehensive Cancer Networks (2)

- The Governance Structure of the CCN should be clear and accountable for the strategy and delivery of the network.
- CCN should be based on legal agreements between CCC and all the partners of the network (coordination, division of tasks and responsibilities among partners)

Expectations from CanCon

- *Make an impact on decision makers in the MSs to endorse quality approach in oncology*
- *Promote closer collaboration between decision makers and cancer centres / institutes / networks to implement quality cancer care*
- *Promote to endorse existing accreditation programmes, namely OECI A&D as official tools for QA in comprehensive cancer care (e.g. Italian MoH)*
