

WP6 – CCCN Definition - 1

“A CCCN consists of multiple Units belonging to different Institutions dedicated to prevention, diagnosis, treatment, follow-up, palliative care and rehabilitation for the benefit of cancer patients and cancer survivors.

Multiple Units

These Units interact and have a formal agreement to work together in a partnership way with common governance, in order to work more effectively and efficiently through collective synergies”

Formal and Written Agreement

WP6 – CCCN Definition - 2

Within the CCCN the care of patients is the responsibility of inter-professional multidisciplinary teams (MDTs) that are primary and tumour-specific. Each team works together for the benefit of patients with that particular type of tumour.

MDTs

Within the CCCN all Units work together and adopt uniform standards of care that are binding for the entire Network.

Uniform Guidelines

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The CCCN promotes a uniform system of quality assurance; and a unified information system for the exchange of information.

Exchange of Data/Info

The objective of a CCCN is to provide comprehensive cancer care to all the people in a geographic area thus pursuing equality of access to services, outcomes and quality
