## Berlin Meeting Main conclusions (1): Costs

- \* Assessment of costs very complex issue both in CCC and CCCN.*
- \* Useful to separate internal vs. external costs*
- \* Not feasible to compare costs and to give evidence of less costs for CCCN. Potential greater “value for care”.*

# WP6

## Berlin Meeting Main conclusions (2): Optimizing CCCN running

- \* Operate by Tumour Management Groups having agreed on the contents of the cooperation*
- \* Potential inclusion in Clinical Trials of a Larger population*
- \* Opportunity/Need to adopt a unified information (informatic) system*
